STAFF IN TRAINING – this program will be limited to six SITs. There is a separate application for this camp available from the Twin Pines Office. The SIT program is meant to train future staff.

CANCELLATION POLICY – A non-refundable, non-transferable \$50.00 deposit per person MUST be sent with each COMPLETED registration form. Cancellation within two weeks of the opening date of the camp week will be charged one-half of the weekly rate.

CAMP WEEK – For most camps the program begins with registration on Sunday at 2:30 pm (no earlier please!) and closes at 10:00am the following Saturday (unless stated otherwise). Please be sure to arrange to pick up your camper by 10:00am. The following camps have special end closing times.

- Moms 'n' Gals and My First Camp begin on **WEDNESDAY AT 7:00 PM** and close on Saturday at 10:00am
- Father "n" Son begins Sunday at 2:30pm and ends at 10am Wednesday.
