

## JOB DESCRIPTION FOR THE SUMMER ASSOCIATE PROGRAM DIRECTOR

JOB TITLE AND PURPOSE	The title of this position will be <b>SUMMER CAMP ASSOCIATE PROGRAM DIRECTOR</b> ; the broad purposes of the position shall include, but not be limited to, responsibility for assisting the Program Director in preparing and presenting a week of programing for the Twin Pines Summer Program.
JOB QUALIFICATIONS	This person shall be at least twenty-one (21) years of age and show signs of leadership and maturity that warrant him/her being entrusted with the lives of campers.

RESPONSIBILITIES	1. This person shall assume responsibility for assisting in the planning of an entire program from check-in through check-out.
	2. This person shall assist the Program Director in carrying out the program that has been planned utilizing the summer staff wherever possible.
	<ol> <li>This person shall serve as the "ambulance driver" to take campers and/or staff to one of the doctors or medical centers if the need arises during his/her week of camp.</li> </ol>
JOB ACCOUNTABILITY	The person hired in the position of <b>SUMMER CAMP ASSOCIATE PROGRAM DIRECTOR</b> is directly amenable to the Executive Director.
JOB CLASSIFICATION OSHA COMPLIANCE	This position, <b>SUMMER CAMP PROGRAM DIRECTOR</b> , has been classified as a <u>CATEGORY</u> II exposure since this position is not responsible for providing any first-aid assistance and has only collateral possibility for exposure.
